The Center is conveniently located adjacent to the District's Administration building on Old Richmond Road, 10 minutes from Highway 59 and the Grand Parkway, 5 minutes from Highway 6, close to Beltway 8, and easily accessible from downtown Houston. The lovely new facility is ideally suited for:

- Business Meetings
- Seminars
- Civic club meetings
- Training sessions
- Special Family Events
- Senior citizen groups.

The Meeting Room is comfortably appointed with a full size conference table and 20 comfortable chairs. There is also adequate room for a maximum of 60 people in folding chairs around the room. The Center is Handicap Accessible, and there are several nearby parking areas.

The Center is equipped with a podium and audio/visual aids, and arrangements can be made for the use of the projector and screen.

There is a fully equipped kitchen that is also available for use during your special meeting or event. While there are no specific rules about food service in the meeting room, guests are required to return the Center to the condition in which they found it. There is

a janitorial fee included in the rental agreement.
